

PROCEDURE TO DOWNLOAD A GPX FILE INTO ALLTRAILS

You can only do this from the PC/Mac using AllTrails website, not from your phone. After you download to your computer the downloaded trails will also appear on your phone. Please direct all questions to Clive Probert. clive.probert@gmail.com.

- Go to SCOV website, navigate to GUIDES INFO, MAPS AND TRACKS, pick the trail you want.
- Download and put it in a file folder so you know where it is.
- On your PC/Mac log into your Alltrails account
- Click HISTORY, RECORDINGS
- Scroll to bottom of recordings
- Click UPLOAD FILE
- Drag the gpx file you want into the box, or click to upload
- Click UPLOAD
- Enter a name for the hike
- You are done

To see and use your new gpx trail map on your phone

- Press HISTORY
- Scroll down to the new trail
- Press map of new trail
- Press map again when recorded route comes up
- You can then examine the route, zoom in, out, change map layers etc and see your location (blue dot), so you could just use this for navigation. (Cannot use DOWNLOAD unless you have the Pro version)
- If you want to record your track as well then press the THREE DOTS. LOAD INTO RECORDER
